

CLUB RULES

1. The last person leaving the club should turn off all lights on dock and in clubhouse and lock clubhouse. If in doubt lock up.
2. Dispose of trash in trashcans. Do not litter.
3. Do not throw debris; skip stones, etc, in swimming or sailing areas.
4. All pets should be leashed, caged, or under strict control while on club grounds. Exceptions: If no other members are present, unrestrained pets are permissible. The caretaker may depend on a dog or dogs as a security measure. Pet owners should police up after their animals.
5. All keys to club locks are the property of MSSC and are issued to memberships only. Keys should not be given to non-members. Replacement keys will be provided at member's expense.
6. Members are responsible for the conduct of family members and guests. Children under six years of age should be under supervision at all times.
7. Dumping of marine heads, camper holding tanks, and portable potties, should **NEVER** be done in inside toilets. A sanitary dumping station is located on the North side of the clubhouse behind the kitchen near the outside faucet, and should be used for all sanitary refuse. Care should be taken not to dump residue that contains bacteria killing chemicals into the septic tank system. Unsuitable items should not be placed in toilets or in dumping stations.
8. Camping is permitted in a designated area separate from the parking lots and storage areas. The camping area is to the southeast of the clubhouse at the river's edge. RVs desiring electric hookup pay a nominal fee and park where instructed by the vice-commodore from whom permission for hookup is obtained.
9. Group activities' involving groups of nonmembers are permitted, but require 30 day's notice to the Board. A club member must sponsor the event, be present during its occurrence, and is responsible for all damages or infractions resulting from the activity. A fee of up to \$50 may be charged for use of the facilities.
10. The nonmember crew of a member's boat is a guest. A nonmember may not sail a member's boat without the member being present, except in emergencies.
11. At no time shall any wildlife on the premises of MSSC be endangered, tampered with, or destroyed, unless they pose a hazard to people (poisonous snakes, etc.). MSSC shall be known as a wildlife refuge. The Board of Governors will discipline any member or guest not observing this status.
12. Members and guests spending the night on club property: (a) Shall not sleep in the clubhouse except in emergencies (Exceptions to this rule may be granted by the board during regattas). (b) Shall not, make disturbances or loud noises after 10:00 p.m. (c) Shall build campfires in safe locations and attend them until they burn out. (d) Shall not drive vehicles through camping areas.
13. Do not store flammable liquids in the clubhouse.
14. The clubhouse, particularly the kitchen area, will be left in a clean condition.
15. Projectile weapons will not be used or displayed except in connection with club-sponsored events.
16. By submitting application for membership in MSSC, applicant agrees for himself, for his heirs, spouse and guest to specifically assume any risk inherent in any activity involving MSSC and club property, both land and water. The club is not responsible for loss, damage, or injury to persons or property on club premises.
17. Do not leave food in the refrigerators when you depart the club. Personal food should be stored in refrigerator
18. The board must approve any additions or changes to the clubhouse or club grounds.
